Resolution No.1

Dr.V.K. Sahgel, Chairman of the meeting appealed KVK to come-up with economically viable and technologically feasible enterprises for sustainable farm production and economic returns. Also suggested to educate livestock owners in respect of preparation of cost effective diets utilizing locally available feed stuffs to feed animals and maintain good health status and better reproductive performance.

Resolution No.2

Mr.G.K.Deori, Manager, Arunachal Pradesh Rural Bank,Roing advised farming communities to take in to consideration of soil and environmental factors at the time of adopting improved agricultural practices.

Resolution No .3

Mr. Yomjan Kamdak, Agriculture Development officer suggested to take initiatives to introduce different types of mushroom such as button mushroom for higher income generation and self sustenance of Self Help Groups(SHG) formed by various developmental departments and NGOs in the district.

Resolution No .4

Mr.Jatan Pulu, an innovative as well as organic farmer belonging to Yibuk village opined that there is a need for availability of right quality seed at right time to take up commercial cultivation of crops based on season and climatic conditions.

Resolution No.5

Mr.Jiko Linggi, Media Person as well as an energetic and enthusiastic rural youth from Abali village urged to ensure consistent supply of mushroom spawn from the centre through establishing mushroom spawn production unit at the KVK office so that sustainable income and livelihood can be assured for resource poor farmers.

Also suggested to develop crop calendar for educating farming community on improved agricultural practices as well as to introduce solar cooker to reduce time and cumbersome procedures involved in cooking of feed stuff for feeding pigs.

Resolution No.6

Mr. Okili Linggi, a progressive poultry farmer hailing from Rukmo village appreciated the cooperation and any time services available from the centre to aspirant farmers from different pockets of the district as well as bordering state. Also expressed that he has gained required knowledge, motivated and inspired through participation in exposure visits organized through centre utilizing financial supports from outside agencies.

In addition to this shared his practical experiences on successful backyard poultry (Vanaraja and Giriraja breeds) farming as well as integrated aquaculture (Duck cum fish farming) practices.

Resolution No.7

Mrs .Oimang Lego, President of Self Help Group-Ledum demanded for distribution of women friendly tools such as tubular maize sheller among group members as there is immense demand for viable good quality seeds . The seed thus collected using sheller is of excellent suitable for sowing and reaping good crop.
